QUICK INSTALLATION GUIDE

Premium Built-in Refrigerator/Freezer Columns



STEP 1

Allow Refrigerator to Rest Before Use

- Wait **24 hours** before turning on the refrigerator.
- This ensures the compressor oil settles properly, especially if the unit was transported lying down or at an angle.
- **Important:** Skipping this step may damage the compressor and affect cooling performance.

STEP 2

Install the Anti-Tilt Bracket

(see install manual: p 14, 21-23)

 Mount the anti-tilt bracket securely to prevent the refrigerator from tipping.



STEP 3

Install the Insulation Blanket

(see install manual: p 57)

• For side-by-side installations, mount the insulation blanket on the freezer column side next to a refrigerator column.

STEP 4

Leveling and Door Alignment

(see install manual: p 26, 27)

- Ensure all leveling feet are properly adjusted to stabilize the refrigerator.
- Accurate leveling is critical for preventing operational issues and ensuring proper door alignment.

STEP 5

Align the Custom Panel

(see install manual: p 28, 29, 31-42)

- Custom panel weight can affect door sealing.
- Use the adjustment points provided to align the panel and ensure a proper seal. If the product is installed to the incorrect depth within the cabinet niche, the door will not make an effective seal or may not open properly. Use the depth seating tool supplied.



STEP 6

Handle Installation (If Applicable)

- Install the handle kit, making sure to apply the provided Loctite thread locker during installation to prevent loosening over time.
- Refer to the handle installation instructions included in the kit:

For Stainless Steel Panels: Follow the specific guidelines.

For Wood Panels: Use threaded inserts for wood. For multiple installations, ensure correct handle alignment.



STEP 7

Verify Door-Close Sensor

(see install manual: p 34)

- The door-close sensor relies on door magnets.
- If the "door open" alarm activates, check for misaligned or missing magnets, and reposition the magnets as needed.




STEP 8

Inspect Water Line Connections

(see install manual: p 8, 11, 24-25, 29-30, 55)

- After connecting the water line, inspect all connectors and hoses for leaks.
- Perform this step before sliding the refrigerator into its niche or securing it to adjacent cabinetry.
- Important: Fix leaks immediately to avoid damage to floors or cabinets.



STEP 9

Activate the Ice Maker (If Any)

(see user manual: p 6, 9)

 After installation, turn on the ice maker to start production.



STEP 10

Activate the Water Dispenser (If Any)

(see user manual: p 6, 9)

• After installation, turn on the water dispenser for proper operation.



STEP 11

Install the Water Filter or the Bypass Plug (see user manual: p 10)

- Depending on your setup, install either the water filter or the bypass plug to enable the use of the ice maker and water dispenser. Refer to the user manual for guidance.
- Replace the filter regularly as indicated in the user manual.
